With unwavering determination, he balanced a demanding schedule—working nights and attending training during the day.

During the course, Abhay stood out for his practical skills, strong work ethic, and natural leadership. His technical understanding, particularly in hands-on solar and electrical applications, was exceptional. These qualities earned him the respect of trainers and peers alike.

Upon completion of the course, Mahiti Trust facilitated a campus placement drive in collaboration with **Tata Renewable Energy Company (Mahadevpura).** Abhay was selected and now earns handsome monthly salary—a milestone that brought stability to his family and alleviated their financial struggles.

Recognizing the potential of vocational education with life skills to uplift others in his community, he joined hands with fellow students to produce a promotional video for the training center. Circulated widely on social media, the video inspired many unemployed youths from the surrounding areas to enrol. As a result, participation in the next batch of the program significantly increased.
